A web farm consists of two or more computer servers that are linked together. They provide extra computer resources—including processors, memory, and storage— and can dramatically increase the amount of computing power at hand to help manage growing website content and traffic.

Even if you're the webmaster for a small business, you can benefit from web farm support by starting with a two-server configuration. One server can be the main computer and the second can load balance heavy traffic during peak periods. As your business and website needs grow, you can increase your computing resources as appropriate to ensure that both business and customer needs are met.

Boosting Productivity

As your site grows the need for your site administrators to edit and maintain content increases. Your site administrators and content editors will appreciate capabilities that improve productivity. Evoq Content provides a wide variety of time saving features.

HTML Pro Module Enhancements

The HTML Pro Module is one of the most frequently used modules by site administrators and content editors. In addition to a robust suite of rich content editing capabilities, it also offers the Version Compare and Auto Save and Rollback productivity features.

With Version Compare, you can view different versions of website content side by side allowing you to easily see what content has been added, deleted, or modified. You can choose to highlight text changes, or for greater detail, you can switch to the HTML view to see the actual code changes.

The HTML Pro Module also includes Auto Save and Rollback. Every few seconds the software takes a snapshot of draft versions of content. In the case of an unexpected disruption—for example, your browser freezes or you accidently close the wrong tab—it's simple to pull up the last saved version and begin working again, eliminating the need to recreate lost content from scratch.

Site Groups

If your organization is planning to deploy multiple DNN websites, the Site Groups capability will allow you to manage users across sites more efficiently. Site Groups give you the ability to group multiple websites and share users and user profile data across sites. It also enables you to offer single sign on for multiple DNN sites.

Cross-Site Module Sharing

Using the Site Groups functionality, you can also share modules and content across multiple sites, eliminating the time-consuming chore of recreating content. This simplifies maintenance by allowing you to update content once and have changes reflected across any associated sites. This can be especially valuable for companies with mobile sites or with many internal departmental sites.

On-the-Spot Editing for Content Approvers

Evoq Content users rely on the powerful content workflow tools to ensure that only appropriate, approved content reaches a site. Sometimes, however, reviewers may want to make small changes on the spot—maybe to correct a typo or add a sentence to a product description—without needing to send



content back to the content creator, resulting in another workflow cycle. Now content reviewers can make those changes immediately, which cuts down on the time needed to get content approved and published.

When your website grows to the point where there are thousands of pages or different kinds of content, it will get harder and harder to keep track of your daily responsibilities. The My Work Dashboard addresses this problem by allowing every content creator or administrator to identify

Keeping it Safe

Few things are more likely to keep a webmaster up at night than the prospect of an attack on the organization's website. The site could be defaced, confidential information compromised, or an entire network could be breached. Even more troubling is the fact that many people responsible for websites don't even know that their sites have been attacked. pages, or distribute malware. About half discovered they were hacked after seeing a warning in a browser or search engine when visiting their own site and 63 percent reported that they did not know how they were hacked.



Keeping hackers at bay requires a lot of diligence and some good technology. Fortunately, Evoq Content provides enhanced protection. You can take advantage of the File Integrity Checker, which is aware of the unique IDs for all files associated with your DNN installation. It offers a diagnostic tool to help you see if any files have been added, deleted, or modified, and provides proactive notifications of security patches. The Health Monitoring feature provides alerts if some activity, including external hacks, causes your site to go offline. The Security Center feature keeps you up to date on known and resolved security issues that can affect your DNN system.

Implementing Access Controls

Another serious concern for webmasters is the possibility that the wrong people access your website content. Evoq Content addresses this with powerful tools to manage site access.

In Evoq Content you can select individuals or groups of users and then give them rights to access content or particular portions of a site to perform specific tasks. These "access control lists" provide precise, granular controls that determine which individuals and departments can add, modify, and delete content as well as make changes to the design of a site. In addition to the "view" and "edit" options that are available in the Platform, the commercial edition allows you to set permissions based on security roles at the site, page, module, and file manager levels. These permissions can allow a user to add or edit content and pages, manage settings, and more.

Implementing Quality Controls

Along with access controls, Evoq Content provides tools for determining how content is reviewed and approved before being published. Content Approval Workflows help reduce or eliminate the possibility of unedited, inappropriate, or unauthorized content being published on a site. Evoq Content includes a set of pre-defined workflows and the ability to add custom workflows that match your businesses approval process.

Enhanced Document Management

As the volume of content on your website grows, you will need better, more efficient ways of managing documents. Evoq Content offers two powerful solutions for facilitating document management: The Document Library Module and the Microsoft SharePoint Connector.

Document Library Module

The Document Library Module is a comprehensive document management solution that lets you store, control, and view your documents online. It's a particularly powerful tool for organizations that use intranets to share documents internally.

Users can create document libraries from scratch or point to a pre-existing folder structure, with automatic synchronization between the new document library



and the existing folders. Users can also monitor changes using subscriptions and alerts, including RSS subscriptions. Versioning allows users to save versions of a document and then restore older versions on demand. A chronological list of the document versions is available which allows restore or simply download of an older version.

The Document Library supports the DNN folder provider, which allows documents to be stored in the DNN file system, database, or in popular cloud services like Amazon S3 and Windows Azure.

Microsoft SharePoint Connector

Microsoft SharePoint is one of the world's leading systems for managing documents. Unfortunately, most web content management systems make it difficult and expensive to publish content stored in SharePoint to external websites. With Evoq Content³, however, you get out-of-the box integration with SharePoint using the Microsoft SharePoint Connector for DNN. The SharePoint Connector helps improve user productivity by giving users more options for accessing, viewing, and editing documents, whether through the web or through the powerful SharePoint platform.

With the SharePoint Connector, you have the flexibility to use either a live or synchronized connection to your DNN site. The live connection provides real-time, bi-directional publishing that allows changes to be made either in SharePoint or on the DNN site,

with the changes updated in both systems. The synchronized connection gives you the option to schedule push updates to your DNN site without opening a connection through your firewall.

Reaching Mobile Users

Evoq Content offers an enhanced mobile solution that incorporates device detection and redirection to mobile-specific site content, enabling a fully optimized mobile experience for site visitors. With the mobile solution you have the flexibility to dramatically reduce the amount of content displayed, simplify navigation, or prioritize lists of product items so that they are more discoverable by mobile visitors using small screens. To simplify the development and maintenance of mobile site content, modules and their associated content can be shared between desktop and mobile sites. This shared content feature allows Evoq Content to support both Responsive Web Design as well as stand-alone mobile sites.

mobile devices that is updated weekly. It also provides the ability to identify devices based on over 100 attributes, including the popular "isTablet" attribute, which allows tablet devices to be redirected to web pages or sites optimized for that form factor.

The solution provides a mobile template that can serve as a starting point for developing your mobile site. It leverages RWD techniques where appropriate eCommerce solution for organizations selling a moderate number of goods or services.
